You must have a GPA of 3.5 or higher at your current school or at a combination of your current school plus all schools previously attended. Consideration may be given to students with a GPA between 3.2 and 3.49 with special circumstances. Send all transcripts to New Leader Scholarship, c/o 10,000 Degrees, 1650 Los Gamos Dr., Suite 110, San Rafael, CA 94903. Transcripts must be postmarked by March 10, 2014.

III. LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

You must provide two letters of recommendation, one of which must be from a **FACULTY** member at your current school. IV. INTERVIEWS
